Attached 3/4" Brass washer marked "LS 866" to lower blaze of each new BT.

Found - Projecting 6" in mound of stone, the 2" dia. galvanized iron pipe, with 3" dia. brass cap (properly) mkd. as recorded on (in) 1968. Add the mks. "CS 1988" to said brass cap, from which, original BTs recorded by C. Campbell in 1902, fd. as follows:

Hemlock snag. 22" dia., with complete set of scribing visible, brs. S.14½°E., 42.4 ft. to center of tree at base. Rec; S.14°E., 42.24 ft.

Hemlock, 28" dia., with axed into and partly rehealed single face, brs. N.6½°W., 26.90 ft. to center of tree at base. Record; 44.88 ft.

The original Southwest bearing tree, a tipped over hemlock has slid (northeasterly) down hill.

Bearing tree mkd. on C.S. 55/87 fd:

D.Fir, 52" dia., containing scribe mks. including "32SR2W" in partially exposed face, brs. N.71½°E., 31.4 ft. to center of tree at base. Rec. N.69°E., 29.5 ft.

Bearing trees mkd. on M84-5, 1980 fd:

Yew, 11" dia., scribed as recorded, brs. S.34°E., 32.1 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; S.31°40'E., 32.0 ft.

Madrone, 6" dia., scribed as recorded, brs. S.7°W., 4.8 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze. Record; S.6°52'W., 5.5 ft.

Mk a new tree "CS" "BT":

Hemlock, 7" dia., brs. N.55°E., 11.8 ft. to center of tree at lower blaze.

Corner lies on Northeast (45%) slope about 40 ft. South of dry branch, c. East.

V = 18°
