Found - A 10" now 15" Madrone bears N.89°E., 18.5 ft. north  
face of tree is split off. Remainder of blaze is  
partially healed with visible scribing "BT"  
A 15" now 16" Madrone bears S.72°E., 26.1 ft. with  
a partially healed, rotted out blaze. North half  
and top of tree is dead.  
Set - A 1"x36" IP with brass cap 6" above ground mkd:

New BT - A 6" Madrone bears N.26½°W., 38.3 ft. bark scribed
