Set a serpentine stone 18x8x6", 12" in the ground for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, & 28 mkd with 2 notches on S & 3 notch(es) on E edges, from which
A fir, 20" dia. bears N.66°E., 27 lks mkd: T32S R3W S22 BT
A fir, 14" dia. bears S.47°E., 59 lks mkd: T32S R3W S27 BT
A fir, 20" dia. bears S.18°W., 44 lks mkd: T32S R3W S28 BT
An alder, 6" dia., bears N.27°W., 9 lks., mkd: T32S R3W S21 BT.

The corner of secs. 21, 22, 27, & 28, T32S R3W, WM which is a serpentine stone 8x6x6" above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
I begin at cor. No. 1 of this survey, identical with the corner of secs. 21, 22, 27, & 28. I mark the stone with a cross for chaining point and alongside of cor.
Set a granite stone 24x8x6" 14" in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross, mkd. 1 HES 186 on side facing the claim.

20" now 42" D.Fir S.18°W., 29.0 ft. shows good scar.
9" now 16" Alder, N.27°W., 5.3 ft. rotted face, old axework.
