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Cor. No. 16, identical with cor. No. 1 of listing survey, which I destroy and in its place: Set a granite stone 25x8x8", 15" in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 16 of this survey, mkd. 16 HES 186 on side facing the claim, from which

A fir, 36" dia., bears N.42°30'E., 82 lks., mkd: X 16 HES 186 BT.

A fir, 40" dia., bears S.70°45'E., 39 lks., mkd: X 16 HES 186 BT.

Raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high 3½ ft. dist. within the claim.

New BTs- 5" D.Fir S.33°E., 13.9 ft. mkd: "16 HES 186 CS BT" \*11" W.Fir N.43°E., 17.5 ft. mkd. "16 HES 186 CS BT"

This corner lies on flat. Corner #15 bears S.77°W., 86.5 ft. \*Added to typed info 5/6/1982 VL - left off of orig. typing.

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Found - 1½" IP with 1969 county brass cap properly mkd., firmly set, projecting 4" above 2 ft. dia. mound of stone.

50" D.Fir stump, S.70¾°E., 25.7 ft. with fragmentary scribe marks visible on previously opened blaze.

18" W.Fir, N.43°E., 17.5 ft. with healed blaze.

12" D.Fir, S.33°E., 13.9 ft. with healed blaze.

Corner #15, HES #186, bears S.77°W., 85.7 ft. (Rec. 86.5 ft.)

Set - 6 ft. steel fence post, S.77°W., 1.4 ft. with USFS sign #54-4 attached. Corner is about 120 ft. east of USFS Rd. #3231 at Rock Quarry.
