At point of intersection: Set a granite stone 24x8x8", 14" in the ground, over a stone mkd. with a cross for cor. No. 17 of this survey, mkd. CC on north face and 17 HES 186 on side facing the claim, from which

 A fir 32" dia., bears S.81°30'W., 61 lks., mkd X 17 HES 186 BT.
