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"To a large extent this survey is a check on a part of the surveys of 1944 and 1946 which determined the center of this section by intersection of the two lines from the respective quarter section corners." (1944 and 1946 surveys not of record in DCS0. V.L.)

At the legal center of section 31, We drove a 3/4" galv. I.Pipe within a larger pipe in place and put a cap on the 3/4" pipe die marked "CENTER SECTION 31 1543", from which 33" R.Fir bears S.77°58'W., 76.3 ft. dist., mkd. on bark CEN SEC. 31, BT 1543.

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Found - 3/4" Iron pipe with cap mkd. Center Sec. 31.  
Stump of BT S.77°58'W., 76.3 ft. bark scribed.  
Took two new bearings:

RR Rail mkd. RR property line, N.14°45'E., 114.4 ft.  
Both rails set in ground and extend about 3 ft. above ground.
