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Set a chinquapin post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 18" in the ground, marked S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N side, from which;  
A fir, 50" dia., bears S.85°W., 17 lks., mkd: S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.  
A fir, 24" dia., bears N.65°W., 75 lks., mkd: S C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

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No trace of this  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. but we did find a bluff 20' ft. 19.8 south of approx.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. Plus the approx.  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. lies in an old creek bed.
