A Fir 40" dia., bears N.54°E., 61 lks. dist. mkd. T32S R8W S30 BT.  
A Fir 10" dia., bears S.36°E., 93 lks. dist. mkd. T32S R8W S31 BT.  
A Fir 32" dia., bears S.25°W., 100 lks. dist .mkd. T32S R9W S36 BT.  
A Fir 22" dia., bears N.47°W., 68 lks. dist. mkd. T32S R9W S25 BT.

GLO Resurvey by Fred Mensch and Gerald A. Sorrels, Surveyors under Special Instructions, Group #35, dated Dec. 22, 1916 - (DCSO records Vol. 21 Page(s) 8838-39)

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Intersect the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a basalt stone, 6x12x8 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
