Set a stone 24x12x12", 16" in the ground for the cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28, & 29, marked with two notches on the South & 4 notches on the E angles, and from which

A laurel, 6" dia., bears N.64°E., 72 lks., mkd: T32S R8W S21 BT.

A live oak, 6" dia., bears S.84°E., 65 lks., mkd: T32S R8W S28 BT.

A fir, 18" dia. bears S.70°W. 58 lks. mkd: T32S R8W S29 BT

A fir, 22" dia. bears N.5°W., 23 lks. mkd: T32S R8W S20 BT

Found - 1959 cadastral brass cap at section corner.

Orig. 18" now 30" D.Fir S.70°W., 38.3 ft., faint bark scribe "S29 R"

Orig. 22" now 35" D.Fir N.5°E., (Rec. N.5°W.) 14.4 ft. (Rec. 15.9') faint bark scribe "S R T3". New bark scribe "T32 R8W S21 BT"

New BTs- 14" cedar, now 14" N.38°W., 56.0 ft. scribe visible. 8" Chinq. S.85°E., 57.4 ft. mkd: T32S R8W S28 CS BT.

Reblazed & rescribed -

30" D.Fir S.70°W., 38.3 ft. mkd: T32S R8W S29 CS BT.

Note - This corner lies in fill approx. 20 ft. north of old road.

The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 & 29, determined at record distance from the two remaining original bearing trees:

A fir, 23" dia., bears N.5°E., 23 lks., bark scribed T32S R8W S20 BT. (Record bearing, N.50°W.) Rescribe this tree T32SR8W S21 BT below the other marks.

A fir, 24" dia., bears S.70°W., 58 lks., bark scribed T32S R8W S29 BT.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 18" in the ground, with brass cap marked:

T32S	R8W
S 20	S 21
S 29	S 28
