Set a chinquapin post, 3 ft. long, 3" sq., 20" in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N side; from which
A fir, 30" dia., bears S.20°E., 20 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.
A laurel, 5" dia., bears N.45°W., 29 lks., mkd: ¼ S BT.

Reported as not found.
Found - Good E-W brushed line. Also round probably fir bearing tree. However area is in old burn, bark on old stobs badly burnt.

Set - Proportional measurement, 2½" brass cap on a 1"x30" iron pipe, marked "T32S R8W ¼ S9 S16 RLS 430 1994"
New - 8" D.Fir, bears N.5°W., 15.5 ft. scribed "¼ S9 BT"
10" D.Fir, bears N.30°E., 18.1 ft. scribed "¼ S9 BT"
10" D.Fir, bears S.22°E., 11.1 ft. scribed "¼ S16 BT"
8" D.Fir, bears S.22°W., 13.8 ft. scribed "¼ S16 BT"
6 ft. steel fence post bears West, 1.0 ft.
Note- Corner lies 40 ft. west of top of main ridge which bears N.80°E. and S.80°W.

BLM dependent resurvey by Terrence O. Nickerson, Cadastral Surveyor under Group #2004, survey March/Oct. 2002- (DCSO records Vol. 54 Page(s) 21095-6)

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 9 & 16, reestablished at proportionate measurement and recorded by Shaner, in 1994. There is no remaining evidence of the original cor., therefore this point is accepted as the corner; monumented with an iron post, 1½" dia., firmly set, projecting 14" above the ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which bearing trees mkd. by Shaner
A fir, 8" dia., bears N.1¼°E., 15.5 ft. with healed blaze.
A fir, 10" dia. bears N.26¼°E., 17.9 ft. with healed blaze
A fir, 12" dia. bears S.22°E., 11.0 ft. with healed blaze.
A fir, 11" dia. bears S.18°W., 13.8 ft. with healed blaze.
