

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. Secs. 13 & 24

Set a laurel post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 20" in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S on N side and from which

A fir, 16" dia., bears N.18°E., 79 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

A S.Pine, 36" dia., bears S.85°W., 85 lks., mkd: 1/4 S BT.

Lorne Swearingen - For: The Robert Dollar Co. - Wit: Robert A Harris & Milner Larson - April 15, 1960 - C.S. File 51/63-5

Found in poor condition.

The BT for Sec. 13 is still in good condition.

The BT for Sec. 24 was a 40" Sugar Pine which evidently had been bark scribed & had been felled in a clear cut logging operation.

I marked the corner with a 1 1/4" (OD) iron pipe driven 20" in the ground:

8" D.Fir S.34°E., 25.3 ft., was referenced & scribed S24 1/4 4186 BT.

BLM Dependent resurvey by Arthur R. Rambo, Cadastral Surveyor under Group No. 2179, surveyed July/Nov. 2007 - (DCSO records, Vol. 55 Page(s) 21613-4)

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, perpetuated by Swearingen, in 1960, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 1/4" dia., firmly set, projecting 14" above the ground, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir, 52" dia. bears N.18°E. 52.1 ft. with a healed blaze

A sawed rotted pine stump, 36" dia., bears S.78°W., 49.5 ft., no marks visible. (Record, S.85°W., 56.1 ft.)

and a bearing tree mkd. by Swearingen, in 1960

A fir, 24" dia., bears S.34°E., 25.3 ft., with a healed double blaze.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 23" in the ground, directly over the iron pipe, in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a magnet in a white plastic case at the base of the stainless steel post.
