Old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Corner and witness trees standing and agreeing with notes furnished by the surveyor general.

 An Alder 14" dia., bears S.59°W., 50 lks. dist., mkd. AP BT. (Old BT)
 An Alder 24" dia., bears N.56°W., 42 lks. dist. mkd. AP BT. (Old BT.)
