NOT IN DOUGLAS COUNTY

GLO survey by Oscar F. Thiel, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract #729, dated Dec. 24, 1900 and special instructions dated Sept. 12, 1901 (DCSO records Vol. 21 Page(s) 9053)

Set a granite stone, 14x12x8", 10" in the ground for corner of secs. 7, 8, 17, & 18, mkd with 4 notches on S. & 5 notches on E. edges, from which

- A Laurel, 8" dia., bears N.71°E., 24 lks., mkd. T33S R7W S8 BT.
- A Laurel, 8" dia., bears S.54°E., 34 lks., mkd. T33S R7W S17 BT.
- A Laurel, 14" dia., bears S.45°W., 109 lks., mkd. T33S R7W S18 BT.
- A Sugar Pine, 50" dia, bears N.66°W., 66 lks., mkd. T33S R7W S7 BT.

This corner stands 100' above Reuben's Creek.

BLM resurvey by Lynn M. Roseberry and Rollin D. Aanrud, Cadastral Surveyors, Under Group #845, surveyed April/Nov. 1975 (DCSO records Vol. 41 Page(s) 16284-5)

From the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, & 18, monumented with the original granite stone, 14x12x8", firmly set 6" in the ground, with 4 notches on S. and 5 notches on E. edges, from which the remains of the original BTs:

- A madrone, 13" dia., bears N.71°E., 24 lks., no marks visible on opened decayed blaze.
- A madrone, 15" dia., bears S.54°E., 34 lks., with healed blaze.
- A madrone, 19" dia., bears S.45°W., 99 lks., with healed blaze. (Record, 109 lks.)
- A sugar pine snag, 60" dia., bears N.66°W., 68½ lks., no marks visible. (Record, 66 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

from which new bearing trees

- A fir, 7" dia. bears N.45°E., 15½ lks. mkd. T33S R7W S8 BT
- A madrone, 8" dia., bears S.64½°W., 24½ lks., mkd. T33S R7W S18 BT.
- A fir, 23" dia., bears N.31 3/4°W., 120½ lks., mkd. T33S R7W S7 BT.

Deposit corner stone alongside iron post.
