

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Boundaries
of Donation Land Claim No. 37, T. 22 S., R. 6 W.,
Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS	
	Descend 145 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
15.41	Intersect the E. and W. center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 17. From this point, the center N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 17, bears N. 89° 55' W., 0.29 chs. dist., hereinafter described. Descend slightly over NW. slope.
15.74	Intersect the N. and S. center line of sec. 17. Point for the crossing closing cor. of the N. and S. center line of sec. 17 with the S. bdy. of Claim No. 37, hereinafter described. From this point, the center N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 17 bears S. 0° 56' E., 0.17 chs. dist., hereinafter described. Descend 90 ft. over NW. slope.
27.55	Lancaster Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 10° E.; desc. 75 ft. over W. slope.
56.235	Intersect the line bet. secs. 8 and 17. From this point, the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18, bears N. 89° 45' W., 5.555 chs. dist., hereinbefore described. Descend slightly over gentle W. slope.
77.30	Left bank of Elk Creek, 80 lks. wide, bears E. and W., course W., bending N. 50° W.; continue along creek bottom.
80.20	Point for the SW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 37, determined by the method of broken boundaries, falls at waters edge on left bank of Elk Creek; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set a brass tablet, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam., 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. stem, in drill hole in bedrock, with top mkd.
	T 22 S S 7 DLC 37 R 6 W 1976 from which a reference monument and a bearing object An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 36° E., 192 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. C37 RM 1976, and an arrow pointing to the corner. A sandstone outcropping, bears S. 32° W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. X B0.
39.93	N. 29° 51' E., along the W. bdy. of Claim No. 37. Point for the NW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 37, determined by the method of broken boundaries; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. No permanent monument established.
