## CHAINS

S. 88° 26' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 253 ft. over NW. slope.

11.45 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 304 ft. over NE. slope.

20.25 The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, myrtle, chinquapin, and madrone; undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, hazel, arrowwood, salmonberry, huckleberry, blackberry, poison oak, rhododendron, and fern.

From the SW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 44 on the E bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 45, monumented with a decayed fir stump, 40 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on badly scaled bark blaze, from which the original bearing trees:

A sawed and decayed fir stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 25° E., 19 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on pitch splinter pulled loose from decayed wood near center of stump.

A sawed and decayed fir stump, 39 ins. diam., bears S. 88° W., 14 lks. dist., no marks remaining.

and bearing tree and witness cor. established by the County Surveyor in 1955

A sawed fir stump, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 28° W., 41 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on nearly healed blaze.

An iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 16 ins. above ground, bears East, 5 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd.
