

Resurvey, Portion of Boundaries, Claim No. 45 T. 22 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

The cor. is located in fence line extending N. and S.

South, along the E. bdy. of Claim No. 45.

Ascend slightly over N. slope.

Point for the SE. cor. of Claim No. 45, determined at record bearing and distance from the SW. cor. of Claim No. 44.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A white fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. $44\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., $64\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S28 BT. (This is the same tree as the SE. bearing tree for the SW. cor. of Claim No. 44.)

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 39° W., $16\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T22S R8W S28 BT.

The cor. is located at cor. of fences extending N. and W.

S. $89^{\circ} 33'$ W., along the S. bdy. of Claim No. 45.

Descend 138 ft. over NW. slope, across open field.

Intersect the line bet. secs. 28 and 29.

From this point the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 29, bears N. $8^{\circ} 35'$ W., 19.13 chs. dist.

Sawyer Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 15° E.; asc. 93 ft. over general E. slope.

Leave field, enter timber, edge bears generally N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

Ascend 120 ft. over general E. slope.

Sawyer Creek Road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 35° E. and S. 35° W.

The SW. cor. of Claim No. 45, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree:

A decayed maple stump, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 40 lks. dist., with faint axe and scribe marks visible on decayed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
