I offset north 50 lks thence East 100 lks. thence South 50 lks to line thence East to left bank of river. I set a flag on line at this point on a cross to right bank on line at cor.

To determine the distance across

I measure a base north 5.00 chs to a point from which the flag bears S57°15' W from the flag the N end of the base bears N 57°15' E. therefore the distance is $\tan 57°15' \times \text{base}$ or $1.554 \times 5.00 = 7.77$ which added to 25.00 makes

32.77

The cor. of claim on right bank of Umpqua river. Here I set a post 4 ins square 4 ft long 24 ins in the ground for interior angle of claim 39 marked Cl. 39.

The oad witness tree a Willow now 18 ins dia bears S 70°W 28 lks dist.

The ash now 16 ins diam bears N 15°W 112 lks dist.

Thence I run N. 61°45' E. on south boundary of claim 39.
