DONATION LAND CLAIMS

CHAINS

T22S R9W DLC #42

24.50 Set a sand stone 16 x 10 x 8 ins 12 ins in the ground for S E cor of claim 42.

The witness trees of this cor are both still standing; viz.

A fir 12 ins (now 30 ins) diam bears N 86°W 10.50 chs. dist.

A oak 8 in dia (now 16 ins) bears S 87°W 9.90 chs dist.

This cor is 150 ft below N E cor of claim.

Thence I run West on South bdy of claim 42 va 20°00'E Irregular descent.

16.80 On edge of creek, no post, the creek having washed away the bank. The old bearing tree, a fir 30 ins diam bears S 70°E is still standing. Set a post 4 ins square 4 ft. long in mound of stone, at edge of creek for cor. of inward angle of claim 42 marked C 1.42 on N face. This cor is 100 ft. below S E cor.

Thence I run South on the East boundary of claim 42

1.80 Leave creek 20 lks wide course S 10°E.

7.50 Road to Scottsburg course E and W.

8.00 Fence and field course E and W.

17.25 To S E cor. of claim 42 at Umpqua river, but no trace of any post or bearing trees.

The only indication where the cor has been is the line fence between claims 42 and 43 which agrees with my course. I therefore set an ash post 4 ins square 4 ft. long 24 ins in the ground for S E cor of claim 42 on right bank of Umpqua river.

Thence I run Westward following the meanders of the right bank of the Umpqua river down stream. West 11.41 chs. S 85°30' W 21.35 chs to the beginning cor. and S W cor of claim 42.
