CHAINS

In prosecuting the Surveys of the foregoing Donation Land claims, I traced the lines of a magnetic variation of 20°E and found but little local attraction.

I constantly kept the Latitude and Declination arcs properly set and in every case, though I did not often have Sunshine the true Meridian indicated by the solar gage a Magnetic variation exactly or very nearly 20°E and my courses and measurement corresponded very nearly with the original surveys and in many cases coincided exactly.
