N. 89° 29' W., along the S. bdy. of Claim No. 40.

61.48 Point for the exterior cor. on the S. bdy. of Claim No. 40,  
determined by the method of irregular boundaries; there is no  
remaining evidence of the original corner.

center line of sec. 11, hereinafter described.

Ascend 450 ft. over SE. slope.

12.95 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 315 ft. over NE. slope.

20.20 Bottom of descent, slopes E.; asc. 65 ft. over SE. slope.

22.90 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 285 ft. over NE. slope.

32.80 Mehl Creek road, 30 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.
