From the exterior cor. on the E. bdy. of Donation Land
Claim No. 46, located on the line bet. secs. 15 and 22,
herinbefore described.

N. 0° 37' E., on the E. bdy. of Claim No. 46, marking and
blazing the true line.

Ascend 40 ft. over SE slope, through scattering timber and
dense undergrowth, across logged area.

9.80 Ridge, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.; desc. 25 ft. over NW
slopes.

17.15 Bottom of descent, slopes SW.; asc. 140 ft. over SW. slope.

19.97 Intersect the E. and W. center line of the SE 1/4 of sec. 15

Point for the crossing closing cor. of the E. and W. center line
of the SE 1/4 of sec. 15, with the E. bdy of Claim No. 46,
hereinafter described.

From this point, the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15, bears
N. 89° 32' E., 4.27 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

Ascend 135 ft. over SW slope.

23.00 Ridge, bears N. 25° W. and S. 25° E.; desc. 20 ft. over NE
slope.

27.52 The NE cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 46, monumented with an
iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins.
above ground, with brass cap mkd.
