Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of Donation Land Claim
No. 37, T. 29 S., Rs. 3 and 4 W., Willamette Meridian,
Oregon

CHAINS

(Restoring the Survey by Dennis Hathorn,
U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1857)

From the NE. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 37 (located
in sec. 20, T. 29 S., R. 3 W.), determined at record
bearing and distance from the remains of the original
bearing trees:

An oak root crown, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 33° E.,
60 lks. dist., with a down and decayed oak
alongside, no marks visible.

A root hole, bears S. 85° W., 787 lks. dist., with
a down and decayed oak alongside, size indeter-
minate, no marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which reference monuments

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24
ins. in the ground, for a reference monument,
bears S. 28½° W., 268½ lks. dist., with brass
cap mkd. C37 RM 1977 and an arrow pointing to
the corner.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24
ins. in the ground, for a reference monument,
bears N. 58½° W., 300 lks. dist., with brass
cap mkd. T29S R3W S20 RM 1977 and an arrow
pointing to the corner.

N. 89° 54' W., along the N. bdy. of Claim No. 37.

104.74 Intersect the line bet. secs. 19 and 24, T. 29 S.,
Rs. 3 and 4 W., S. 0° 41' W., 0.01 chs. from the ¼ sec.
cor. of sec. 24 only.

104.773 Intersect the E. and W. center line of sec. 24,
S. 73° 23' W., 0.035 chs. from the ¼ sec. cor. of sec.
24 only, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

Ascend 35 ft. over SE. slope.

114.80 Ridge, bears N. 25° E. and S. 25° W.; desc. 80 ft. over
broken SW. slope.

119.07 The crossing closing cor. of sec. 24, at intersection
with the N. and S. center line of the NE¼ and the N.
bdy. of Claim No. 37, hereinafter described.

From this point, the center E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 24,
bears S. 5° 20' W., 4.425 chs. dist., hereinafter
described.

Descend 100 ft. over SW. slope.

123.10 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 20 ft. over SE.
slope.
