From the SW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 39, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:

An oak, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 2° E., 152 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which a new bearing tree

A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 35° E., 76½ lks. dist., mkd. C39 BT.

S. 89° 32' E., along the S. bdy. of Claim No. 39.

17.70 Wire fence, extends NE. and SW.

18.20 South Myrtle Creek Road, paved, 30 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.

21.75 South Myrtle Creek, 50 lks. wide, course S. 40° W.; asc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.

24.16 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 21, hereinbefore described.

N. 89° 56' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 215 ft. over NW. slope.

11.10 Wire fence, bears N. and S., also enter timber, edge bears same as fence.

18.22 Point for the cor. of original lots 2 and 3, on the S. bdy. of Claim No. 39.
