	<p>A white oak, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 41° W., 82 lks. dist., with scribe marks T29S R6W C41 BT visible on partially healed double blaze.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long. 2 1/2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T 29 S R 6 W C 41 S 15 1971</p> <p>No other suitable trees available within limits.</p> <p>Deposit the iron rod alongside the iron post.</p> <p>N. 89° 43' W., along the S. bdy. of Claim No. 41.</p> <p>Descend 20 ft. over nearly level land, through scattering timber and light undergrowth, marking and blazing the true line.</p>

37.15	West Willis Creek Road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.
39.94	Point for the SW. cor. of Claim No. 41, determined by the method of irregular boundaries, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner; no permanent monument established.

34.50	Spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 100 ft. over NE. slope.
42.25	Dry creek, 3 lks. wide, drains N. 80° E.; asc. 120 ft.
