Dependent Resurvey, Portion of W. Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

22.85 Barbed wire fence, bears E. and W.; enter pasture, edge bears E. and W.

24.70 Top of ascent, slopes NW.; desc. 10 ft. over nearly level pasture.

31.00 Intersect the S. bdy. of the William P. Day Donation Land Claim (Claim No. 37 in T. 29 S., R. 9 W. and Claim No. 44 in T. 29 S., R. 8 W.), no permanent monument established.

From this point the SW. cor. of the William P. Day Donation Land Claim No. 37, bears S. 89° 14' W., 9.80 chains dist., perpetuated and recorded by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1962, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. dist., firmly set, extending 20 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed fir stump, 43 ins. diam., bears N. 43° E., 33 lks. dist., mkd. BT on opened blaze.
(Record, N. 45° E., 31 lks.)

and a bearing tree marked by Byron

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 23 1/2° W., 18 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. CL 37 CS BT on a double blaze.

and new bearing trees

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 29 1/4° E., 79 lks. dist., mkd. DLC 37 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 56° E., 77 lks. dist., mkd. DLC 37 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 55° W., 7 lks. dist. mkd. S36 BT.

Add the marks ELM 1965 to top of brass cap.

From this same point the SE. cor. of the William P. Day Donation Land Claim No. 44, bears N. 89° 14' E., 71.06 chs. dist., perpetuated and recorded by J. W. Cole, County Surveyor, in 1923, when the original bearing tree was still in existence, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, extending 3 ins. above ground.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
