29.00	Top of ridge, course N and S. begin descent.

	Line follows now along South slope of hill crossing the following gulches.
50.50	A deep, narrow gulch, course S.
56.85	A deep narrow gulch, course S.
69.70	A deep, narrow gulch, course S.
71.02	Intersected sec. line bet. sec. 7 and 8 11. 10 chns. North of the 1/4 sec. cor.
71.50	A deep, narrow gulch, course S.
81.50	A deep, narrow gulch, course S.
111.54	The NW. cor. I found a post in place, probably set by the Co. surveyor being marked C 39.; I prove it to be in place by the bearing tree standing. I replace the partly decayed post by cedar post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S. R 4 W. C 39 on SE face, from which
	A fir 36 ins. in diam., bears S 18° E 90 lks dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C. 39 BT. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks being dim, I replace.
	Thence South on West boundary of Claim 39. Va 18° 50' E.
	Through fir timber.
4.00	A branch, 5 lks. wide, course S 30° E. Var. 18° 10' E.; begin ascent of E slope.
11.00	Leave fir timber, enter oak timber.
17.50	Top of rise, begin descent
27.00	Foot of hill.
27.60	Enter grainfield.
38.80	Leave grainfield.
39.24	The witness cor. to the NW cor. of Claim No. 40; 134 lks North of true corner.
39.50	Right bank of S. Umpqua River, course S 80° W
