40.58	<p>SW. cor of Claim 39 and NW cor. of Claim No. 40, is in the middle of river. The witness corner post is gone; but the stump of a wh. fir, corresponding in size and direction with the field notes furnished me, as the bearing tree is standing and Mr. Weaver, owner for a long time of this land, says is the correct tree. I restore this corner by setting a basalt stone 12 x 10 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, 134 lks. North of true cor., marked WC. 39 on NE face, from which</p> <p>A bl. oak 30 ins. in diam. bears S 78° W. 100 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C. 39. W.C. BT. Thence</p> <p>East bet Claims No. 39 and 40.</p> <p>Var. 18° 20' E.</p> <p>I make an offset South from true corner in the river South 2.00 chns thence by traverse:</p> <p>N 81 1/2° E 15.00 chns. making N. 222 lks. S 87 1/2° E 5.16 chns. making S 22 lks = N 200 lks.</p>
20.00	<p>To the cor. and the NE. corner of Claim No. 40. The post set for this cor. is gone; but as the witness cor. to NW cor. of Claim No. 41, bears North 3.00 chns, I run South 3.00 chns., and restore this corner, by setting a basalt stone 14 x 10 x 8 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, marked 39 on NW. face, from which</p> <p>A wh. oak 15 ins. in diam. bears N 39 1/4° W. 60 lks dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 40 BT. Thence</p> <p>North bet. Claims No. 39 and 41.</p> <p>Var. 18° 30' E.</p> <p>Left bank of S. Umpqua river, course S 80° W. Set flagg on line North on right bank, run base East 120 lks. Flagg bears N 21° 5' W. making 311 lks. across, run back outh 11 lks.</p>
2.00	<p>Corner of Claim N. 39 and N.W. cor. of Claim No. 41, is in the river, At 100 lks North of true corner I set a basalt stone 12 x 8 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked 39, W C on NW face from which</p> <p>A bl. oak 20 ins. in diam., bears S 80° W 22 lks dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 39 W.C. B.T. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks I renew.</p> <p>East bet. Claims No. 39 and 41.</p> <p>Var 18° 30' E.</p> <p>As the true line runs up in the river, I make an offset South of true cor. of 205 lks and thence by traverse N 78° E 9.86 chns; making a northing of 205 lks, regained true line.</p>
9.64	<p>Left bank of S. Umpqua River, course S 80° W, regained true line.</p>
20.01	<p>Corner of Claim 39 and the NE. corner of Claim No. 41. The post set for this corner is gone, but the stump of a bl. oak corresponding in size, and direction and bearing with the field notes of original survey, stands, but the marks are entirely obliterated. I restore this corner by setting a basalt stone 10 x 8 x 8 ins. 7 ins. in the ground, marked 39 on NW. face, raised a mound of stone along-side. Thence</p> <p>North, bet. Claims No. 39 and 42 and along sec. line bet. secs. 7 and 8.</p> <p>Va. 18° 30' E.</p>
