4.68	To flagg on right bank of river, in a grainfield.
6.62	To cor. and NW. cor. of claim No. 43. The post set for this cor. is gone, and cultivation has obliterated all traces on the ground; being but a short distance from the NE cor. of 42., This would act as a bearing tree. I restore this cor. by setting a basalt stone 9 x 8 x 8 ins. 6 ins. in the ground, marked 39 on NW. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Thence
	East bet. Claims No 39 and 43.

2.50	Right bank of S. Umpqua river, course S 80° W, make offset, by returning S. to the NE cor. of Claim No. 42 (this line runs in the river nearly all the way) and running by traverse N 64 3/4° E 9.45 chns. and N 77° E 11.75 chns making a Northing of 664 lks. and Easting of 20.00 chns.
20.00	The cor. and NE cor. of Claim No. 43. The old post is gone, but the stump of a Bl. oak, corresponding in size and direction with the description in the field notes furnished, is standing, showing parts of letters BT. I restore this cor. by setting a basalt stone 12 x 8 x 8 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked 39 on NW face, from which
	A bl. oak 36 ins. in diam., bears N 77 3/4° W 196 lks dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C. 39 BT. Thence
	North bet. Claims 39 and 44.
	Var. 18° 20' E.
0.48	Left bank of S. Umpqua river, course S 80° W. Set flagg N. on line on right bank, ran base West 150 lks. flagg bears N 19° 45' E 418 lks across.
4.66	Right bank of river, enter grainfield.
10.00	Leave field, begin steep ascent.
13.73	The cor. and NW. cor. of Claim No. 44. Post set for this cor. is gone, but a Wh. Oak 12 ins. in diam. is standing N 10° E, corresponding in size and direction with the field notes, furnished me; the marks have been chopped out, by the Co. Surveyor probably; I restore this cor. by setting a Wh. oak post, marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 39 on NW face; (4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square 24 ins. in the ground) From which
	A Wh. Oak 12 ins. in diam bears N 10° E 200 lks dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C 39 BT. Thence
	East bet. Claims No. 39 and 44.
	Va 17° 40' E.
	Descending a rocky hillside.
9.00	Foot of descent, enter grainfield
31.20	SE cor. of Claim No. 39 and place of beginning, also exterior or SW. cor. of Claim No. 46.
