R 4 W.</p> <p>Begin at a point 10.00 chns North of the 1/4 sec. post between secs. 7 and 18, in the S. Umpqua river, set a basalt stone 12 x 10 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked W.C. 40 on SE face, and being 134 lks North of true corner, from which</p> <p>A Bl. oak 30 ins in diam. bears S 78° W 100 lks dist. marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 39. W C BT, thence</p> <p>East, along S. boundary of C. 39, between 39 and 40.</p> <p>Var. 18°20'E.</p> <p>Offsett South from true cor. 2.00 chns Thence by traverse</p> <p>N 81 1/2° E 15.00 chns making N. 222 lks.</p> <p>S 87 1/2° E 5.16 chns, making S. 22 lks.</p>
20.00	<p>The NE. corner; and cor. of Claim 39. The post set for this cor. is gone; but the cor. 300 lks North on same line, bears North 300 lks. I restore this corner by setting a basalt rock 14 x 10 x 8 ins 10 ins. in the ground marked 40 on SW. face from which</p> <p>A Wh. oak 15 ins. in diam. bears N 39 1/4°W 60 lks dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 40 BT.</p> <p>Thence South along line bet. Claim 40 and 41.</p> <p>Var. 18°25' E.</p>
1.00	<p>Enter grainfield.</p>
10.10	<p>Intersected sec. line betw. secs. 7 and 18 20.00 chns West of the SE cor. of sec. 7.</p>
49.50	<p>Leave low bottom, enter a bench.</p>
66.50	<p>Begin ascent of W. end of hill, enter oak openings.</p>
72.00	<p>Top of same, begin slight descent.</p>
78.00	<p>SW. cor. of Claim No. 41.</p>
80.00	<p>SE. cor. The post, set for this corner is gone, but the bearing tree is standing. I restore this cor. by setting a fir post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S. R 4 W C. 40 on NW. face, from which</p> <p>A bl. oak, 15 ins. in diam. bears N 68 1/2°W 490 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 40 BT. This is the old bearing tree whose marks being dim, I renew. Thence West.</p> <p>Va. 18°55' E.</p> <p>Descending through prairie.</p>
0.15	<p>Enter grainfield, bears E. and W.</p>
5.20	<p>A branch course NW. 1 lk. wide, enter a thicket of young oaks.</p>
6.60	<p>A branch, course NE, 1 lk. wide.</p>
