15.00 Leave oak timber, enter grainfield

20.00 SW. cor. and East boundary of Claim No. 37. The post set for this cor. is gone, but the stump of bearing tree, a Wh. oak, corresponding in size and direction with the description furnished me, and showing the letters BT. is still standing. I restore this corner by setting a cedar post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S R 4 W, C. 40 on NE face, from which

A Wh. oak, 30 ins. in diam. bears S 27° W. 74 lks dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 40 BT. Thence

North bet. Claims 37 and 40.

Va 18° 25' E

32.50 Enter low bottom land.

38.00 A branch, course North in a dug ditch.

70.00 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 7 and 18 at 1/4 sec. cor.

78.00 The NE. corner of Claim No. 37.

79.00 Left bank of S. Umpqua river.

80.00 The N.W. cor. and place of beginning.
