67.90 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 7 and 18, 20 chns West of the SE cor. of Sec. 7.

77.00 Leave field, road to Canyonville, Course SW.

79.00 The left bank of S. Umpqua river, course SW.

80.00 The NW. corner and place of beginning.
