Begin at the NE. corner of this claim, the old post is gone, but the stump of a Bl. oak on Claim No. 39, and corresponding in size and direction with the description in field notes of survey of Claim 39 (being the same corner) furnished me, is still standing. I restore this cor. by setting a basalt stone 12 x 8 x 8 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked 43 on SW face, From which

A bl. oak 36 ins. in diam., bears N 77 3/4° W 196 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C. 39 BT.

Thence, South bet. Claims No. 43 and 44.

Var. 18° 25' E.

26.94 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 8 and 17 at 1/4 sec. post.

38.00 Leave level bottom enter bench land.

55.00 A branch course NW. 2 lks. wide, oak openings, begin ascent.

69.62 The SW. cor. of Claim No. 44.

80.00 The SE cor. The post set for this cor. is gone, the stump of a laurel corresponding in size and direction with the description in the field notes furnished me and showing parts of BT, is standing. I restore this cor. by setting a fir post 4 1/2 ft. long 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S. R 4 W. C. 43 on NW face, From which

A fir, 8 ins. in diam. bears N 25 1/2° W. 25 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C 43 BT. Thence

West bet. Claims No. 43 and 42.

Var. 18° 45' E.

Through small fir timber, descending.

6.50 Enter underbrush of young oak & laurels

14.00 Enter prairie.

20.00 SW. corner. The post set for this cor. is gone, but the bearing tree is standing. I restore this corner by setting an oak post, 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground marked

T 30 S R 4 W C. 43 on NE. face, from which

A bl. oak, 27 ins. in diam. bears N 15° E, 20 lks dist. marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 43 BT. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks being dim, I renew. Thence

North bet. Claims 43 and 42.

Var 18° 45' E.

Descend through scattering oak timber.

13.20 A gully, course W. enter prairie, level.

32.00 Leave bench land, enter low bottom.

53.25 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 8 and 17, 20.00 chns West of 1/4 sec. post.
