73.38	NE. corner of Claim No. 42.
73.50	Leave grainfield, road to Canyonville, course S 70° W. Set flagg N. on line across the river, lay off base East 90 lks. Flag bears N 11°10'W. making 4.56 chns bet. the flaggs.
74.50	Left bank of S. Umpqua river, course S 70° W. 300 lks. wide.
78.06	To flagg on right bank of river in grainfield.
80.00	The NW corner. The post set for this cor. is gone, and its bearing tree is washed away. I restore this cor. by setting a basalt stone 9 x 8 x 8 ins., 6 ins. in the ground, marked 43 on SE face, raised a mound of stone alongside. Thence East bet. Claims No. 43 and 39. Va. 18° 45' E.
2.50	Right bank of S. Umpqua river, course S 80° W. Make offsett by returning S. to the NE corner of Claim 42 (this North boundary of Claim No. 43 following mostly in the river) and running thence by traverse N 64 3/4° E, 9.45 chns and N 77° E 11.75 chns making a Northing of 664 lks. and Easting of 20.00 chns.
