CHAINS	Claim No. 46 cont.
24.22	Intersected line bet. secs. 4 and 5 16.75 chns North of cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
36.00	Top of ridge bears NE and SW begin descent. Var. 19° 5' E.
65.00	Foot of descent; along S. slope of hill.
76.50	Begin ascent of W. side of spur course N & S.
80.37	The N. E. Corner. A post without marks is in place, probably set by the Co. Surveyor; the bearing tree SE of cor. is standing; and a stump of a Bl. oak, corresponding in size, direction and bearing with the field notes of original survey. I replace the partially decayed post and restore the corner by setting a Laurel post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 on the SW. face, From which  A Bl. oak, 24 ins. in diam. bears S 15° E. 14 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 BT. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks being dim, I renew.  A Laurel, 6 ins. in diam. bears S 47° W. 23 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 BT.

	South on East boundary of Claim No. 46.
	Var. 18° 50' E.
	Descend the SW. slope of hill.
15.56	The NW cor. of Claim No. 47.
17.40	Intersected line bet. secs. 4 and 9. 16.07 chns. East of 1/4 sec. cor. bet. secs. 4 and 9.
55.84	The SE cor.; also the NE cor. of Claim No. 44; set a basalt stone 18 x 10 x 8 ins. in diam. 12 ins. in the ground, marked 46 on N.W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. (Note, as the post set for this cor is gone, and cultivation has obliterated all marks upon the ground, I continued this line to the SE. corner of Claim No. 44 I found the distance to be 75.23 chns. instead of 77.57 chns; therefore Claim No. 46 will lose its proportions of difference (234 lks) namely 173 lks.
	Thence, West bet. Claims No. 44 and 46.
	Va. 18° 40' E.
22.40	Leave grainfield.
25.00	Wagon road, course E & W.
26.00	Right bank of S. Umpqua river, course West, as the line now follows the river, I make an offset North of 5.60 chns.
56.39	Intersect line bet. secs. 8 and 9, 38.83 chns. South of cor. to secs. 8, 9, 4 and 5. (Note the offset is South 33.23 chns.)
66.13	Offset South 5.60 chns. to the SW. cor. of Claim No. 46 and the SE corner of Claim No. 39, standing on edge of right bank of S. Umpqua River, course S 80° W. The post set for this cor. is gone but the trunk of an oak, corresponding in size, bearing and distance with the description, given in the field notes of survey of Claim No. 39 is lying down, Mr. Boyle, who has lived here for
