**CHAINS**

Claim No. 46 cont.

30 years, informs me, that this is the old bearing tree. I restore this cor. by setting a basalt stone 11 x 8 x 6 ins. in a mound of stone, marked 46 on NE face, from which

An alder 16 ins. in diam. bears S 84° E. 10 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 BT.

An alder 12 ins. in diam. bears S 46° W. 8 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 39 BT.

Thence, North bet. Claims No. 46 and 39.

Var. 18° E.

1.00 A branch 10 lks. wide, course S 10° W. Make offset East 75 lks. as the line follows this branch, through dense underbrush.

10.50 Offset West 75 lks. regained true line, at interior angle of Claim No. 46 and NE cor. of Claim No. 39. The post set for this corner is gone, but the stump, of an oak, corresponding in size, bearing and distance, namely A Bl. oak 7 ins. in diam. bearing N 10 1/2° W 32 lks. dist., with the field notes, furnished me, is standing, showing a part of letters, BT.; the other bearing tree was standing in a present grainfield and all traces of the same has disappeared. (Note, this line disagrees in length with the original survey; the owners of the land on both sides, being aware of the discrepancy long ago, settled it by one selling to the other all the square, which lies North of the Claim No. 44)

I restored this cor. by setting an oak post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 on SW face, from which

A Bl. oak 48 ins. in diam., bears N 57 1/2° W 34 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 46 BT.

Thence, West bet. Claims No. 46 and 39.

Var. 18° 12' E.

0.75 A branch 10 lks wide course S 10° E.

4.00 Enter field, bears N. and S.

10.75 Leave field, begin ascent, enter oak timber.

13.50 The SW. or exterior angle corner and place of beginning.
