CLAIM NO. 48

Resurvey of Andrew Thomas Land Claim No. 48. T. 30 S., R. 4 W. in sec. 10. Notification No. 122.

Begin at the SW. cor. Here I found a basalt stone 8 ins. square 4 ins. above ground, well buried which I marked 48 on NE. face. I prove the correctness of its location, by the standing bearing tree, from which

A Bl. oak, 24 ins. in diam. bears N. 32 1/2° E. 200 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C.48 BT. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks being dim, I renew.

Thence, East on South boundary of Claim No.48.

Var. 19° E.

Ascend a sloping bench, through oaks.

0.20 Road to Canyonville, course North.

20.00 SE. or exterior angle corner; found a post without marks in place; replace and restore cor. by setting a fir post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S, R 4 W C.48 on N.W. face, from which

A Bl. oak, 12 ins. in diam. bears S 70° W. 46 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C.48 BT.

A Wh. oak, 7 ins. in diam. bears N 18° W 27 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C.48 BT. This is the original bearing tree, whose marks, being dim, I renew.

Thence, North on E. boundary of Claim No. 48.

Va. 18° 50' E.

Descend a hill, through oak timber.

9.15 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course W., begin ascent.

18.50 Top of rise, sharp descent.

20.00 Interior angle cor. Here I found a basalt stone 15 x 10 x 6 ins. in place, also the bearing tree for this cor. I marked said stone 48 on its NW. face, from which

A Wh. oak, 27 ins. in diam. bears S 5° W. 68 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C. 48 BT. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks I renew.

Thence, East on S. boundary of Claim No. 48.

Var. 18° 50' E.

Ascend a bald hill.

10.50 Top of rise, begin descent, enter timber and brush.

21.70 A branch, 2 lks wide, course N 20° W.

22.50 SE cor. Found a post, set by Co Surveyor in place, the stump of the old bearing tree, to wit. a Wh. oak 30 ins. in diam. and agreeing in dist. and bearing with the one described in the field notes furnished me, and showing BT. still stands. I replace the
