39.64	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, perpetuated and recorded by G. G. Stewart, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1922, and further perpetuated and recorded by James W. A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 82° W., 26 lks. dist., with scribe marks W S9 CS BT visible on open blaze. </div> At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center; margin-left: 100px;"> T 30 S R 4 W <u> S 4 S 3</u> <u> S 9 S 10</u> 1981 </div> from which new bearing trees <div style="margin-left: 40px;"> A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 52 1/2° W., 71 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R4W S9 BT. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W., 57 lks. dist., mkd T30S R4W S4 BT. </div> Reset iron pipe alongside iron post. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay laom. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, chinquapin, madrone, and alder; undergrowth, salal, poison oak, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, fern, and grasses.
