- 1.50 Leave pasture, enter field.
- 5.00 Interior angle corner; the post set for this cor. is gone, but the bearing tree stands. I restore this cor. by setting a cedar post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, marked T 30 S. R 4 W. C. 49 on SE. face, from which

 A Bl. oak 32 ins. in diam. bears N. 51° E 46 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W. C. 49 B.T. This is the old bearing tree, whose marks being dim, I renew. Thence

 West on N. boundary of Claim NO. 49.
- 1.10 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 2 and 3 1297 lks. North of cor. to secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.
- 4.50 Leave grainfield.
- 5.50 A creek 15 lks. wide, course S.
- 11.00 Leave grainfield, ascend oak timber.
- 17.50 NW. cor. and place of beginning.
