**CHAINS**

Claim No. 50 cont.

An Alder, 14 ins. in diam. bears S 26° W. 240 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C.50 BT.

Thence, South on E. boundary of Claim No. 50.

Var. 18° 30' E.

Descend slightly through grainfield, bears E and W.

5.50 A branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW.

24.50 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S 10° E.

28.00 Same branch 2 lks. wide, course S 20° W.

28.60 Leave grainfield; road to Canyonville, course W., enter fir timbered bottom.

30.50 Days Creek, 25 lks. wide, course N 80° W.

33.00 Leave bottom; begin ascent.

35.10 Intersect sect. line betw. secs. 1 and 12, 16.64 chns S 72 1/2° W. of cor. to secs. 1, 12, 6 and 7.

40.00 The SE. corner. The post set for this corner is gone, but the bearing tree, marked T 30 S; R 4 W. C. 50 BT. and Oak, 9 ins. in diam. is standing, but killed by fire. I restore this cor. by setting a sandstone 12 x 8 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, marked 50 on NW. face, from which

A fir 10 ins. in diam. bears N 80° W. 5 lks. dist. marked T 30 S. R 4 W C.50 B.T.

A laurel, 6 ins. in diam. bears N 15° E, 16 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C.50 B.T.

Thence, West, on South boundary of Claim No. 50.

Var. 19° 20' E.

0.50 Top of mountain, begin descent through firs, laurels, and oaks.

8.75 A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N; line skirts North end of hill;

15.77 Intersect sect. line bet. secs. 1 and 12, 6.65 chns N 72 1/2° E of cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Enter level bottom, fir timber.

22.12 Intersected sec. line bet. secs. 1 and 2, 2.00 chns North of cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12. Along road to Canyonville, Course W.

53.20 Days Creek, 30 lks. wide, course S 80° W.

55.00 Leave same creek, course NW.

55.20 Enter garden.

56.00 Leave garden, Days Creek 30 lks. wide course SW.

59.00 Enter grainfield.

65.50 Enter a thicket of young oak.

75.50 Leave thicket, for open prairie.

80.40 The SW. cor. and place of beginning.
