### CLAIM NO. 51

Resurvey of Jacob Amsler's Land Claim No. 51 in T. 30 S., R. 4 W. in sec. 25. Notification No. 134. (Claim No. 39 in T.30-3)

Begin at the NW. cor. The Fir, 10 ins. in diam. as marked for this corner, has decayed, but both the bearing trees are standing. I restore this corner by setting a basalt stone 16 x 8 x 7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground marked 51 on the SE. face from which

A Bl. oak 21 ins. in diam. bears S 80° W, 14 lks. dist., marked T 30 S. R 4 W C.51 B.T.

A fir, 36 ins. in diam. bears N 50 E, 4 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W C.51 BT.

These are the old bearing trees whose dim marks, I renew.

The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26 bears from this corner N 34° W 480 chns dist., making Cl. cor. 3.98 chs South and 2.68 chns east of sec. cor.

Thence, East on North boundary of Claim No. 51.
