	The main part of the lake is about a mile and a half in extent, with a bold rocky shore. The water is fresh and clear and not affected by tide.
	Set meander post on W. side.
	From N. end of island in lake the post on W. side bears N. 79° W. Chained base S. 12° E., 22.55; thence post on W. side bears N. 43° 15' W. Distance over from post to island
