Land, hilly.
 Soil, sandy, 3rd rate.

West between secs. 5 & 32.

Var.19°15'E.

- 4.50 Enter timber.
- 11.50 Leave timber; enter sand.
- 25.50 Set meander post on left bank of stream, outlet of Chillicoos Lake; drove charred stake. The soil is so loose and so sandy that it would be only trifling to conform to the printed manual and the same remark applies to the two succeeding posts on this line.
- Returned 100 lks. on line; chained base S. 8.14; object in line on right bank bears N.52°W.; dist. over 1042.
- 34.92 Set meander post on right bank of Chillicoos Creek, or Ten Mile Creek.
- 40.00 Quarter sec. corner is on the shore of the Pacific Ocean. Set post as firmly as the nature of the place would permit.

Offset of Coast Meridian, Tps. 20 & 21 S., Rs. 12 & 13 W.
 -West Bdrs. of Tps. 20 & 21 S., R. 12 W.-

Courses run and measured to reach the line between Ranges 12 & 13 West where it leaves the shore of the Pacific.

Beginning East 15.50 from the qr. sec. post between secs. 5 & 32, Tps. 19 & 20 S., R. 12 West;
