## Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 12 W.

CHAINS	
72.00	To left bank of Tahkenitch Creek. Set meander post; drove charred stake; raised mound with trench, as per instructions. N.23°E., 8.70 set post.
80.00	Corner of secs. 19, 20, 29 & 30 is in creek. December 31st, 1857.
	East, on random, between secs. 20 & 29.
3.40	Leave creek post (before noted).
40.00	Set temporary qr. sec. post.
81.20	Intersect sec. corner.
	West, on true line, between secs. 20 & 29.
38.50	Enter marsh, course N.
40.60	Set qr. sec. post; from which A willow, 3 in. dia., bears N.46°E., 48 lks. dist. A willow, 3 in. dia., bears S.85°E., 60 lks. dist.
42.50	Leave marsh, course N.
46.32	Right bank of Tahkenitch Creek. A willow, 2 in. dia. is meander corner. Chained over on logs.
48.40	A pine, 1½ in. dia. on left bank of creek. Offset S. 150 to avoid creek.
51.70	Returned to line. Set post on left bank; from which A pine, 10 in. dia., bears N.62½°W., 110 lks. dist. A pine, 24 in. dia., bears S.75°W., 164 lks. dist.
56.70	Ridge, course N. & S.
60.00	Offset S. 2.75 to avoid pond.
65.70	Returned to line.
75.00	Leave brush.
77.80	Set post on left bank of creek; drove charred stake; raised mound with trench, as per instructions.
81.20	To sec. corner.
