79.80	Intersect N. & S. line at the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, on E. bdy. of Tp.
<p>From the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, N.0°3'E., on blazed line, bet. secs. 11 and 12. Gradual descent along W. slope of spur.</p>	
7.00	Top of spur on line, course N.30°W.; steep descent, about 400 ft.
