Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 12 W.

CHAINS	
	From the closing cor. of secs. 23 and 24, I run East, on blank line, bet. secs. 24 and 26.
1.30	Cor. of secs. 25 and 26; thence bet. secs. 24 and 25. Steep ascent about 150 ft.
4.30	Top of spur, course N.; steep descent about 150 ft.
7.25	Dry ravine, course N.; steep ascent about 200 ft.
11.00	Top of spur, course N.; steep descent about 200 ft.
13.50	Spring beach, 1 lk. wide, course N.; steep ascent about 400 ft.
19.50	Top of spur, course N.; across head of draw, course N.
21.00	Top of ridge, course NE. & SW.; dim trail along ridge; descend SE. slope.
29.30	A creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.10°E.; steep ascent about 100 ft.
32.00	Top of spur, course SE.; descend about 100 ft.
37.50	Dry ravine, course SE.; water below line. Ascend about 50 ft.
39.55	To a point 22 lks. N. of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Post gone, both witness trees standing and agree with field notes furnished by the surveyor general. I reestablish the cor. by a spruce tree, 5 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 on N. and $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 on S. sides. Therefore the course of the line bet. secs. 24 and 25 from the closing cor. bet. secs. 23 and 24 and the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. is S.89°41'E. and the distance is 39.55 chs. From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 24 and 25 I continue East, on blank line.
45.00	Top of spur, course SE.; descend about 400 ft.
50.80	Enter marsh, course N. & S.
55.50	A creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.
61.80	Margin of lake, course S. & NW. Open lake about 100 lks. wide; an impassable marsh extends nearly to the township line. Impracticable to establish a base on W. shore of lake, I place a flag at point of intersection and cross to E. shore. From a point on East margin of
