Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 12 W.

CHAINS

A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears S.28°E., 13 lks.dist., marked 1/4 S B T.

A spruce, 36 ins. diam., bears S.69°W., 19 lks.dist., marked 1/4 S 24 B T.

44.90 A creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.

48.50 Wagon road, course NE. & SW.

56.50 Lanes' house 50 lks. E. of line.

57.00 Enter marsh, course E. & W.

63.00 Leave marsh, course E. & W.

67.05 The W. C. to secs. 19 & 24.

Thence I run North on blank line on East bdy. of Sec. 24, and at 13.68 chs. I intersect E. & W. line, 1.21 chs. E. of cor. to secs. 13 & 24.

Returning to W. C. I run

N.5°3'W., on true line, along East bdy. of Sec. 24.

Enter marsh, course NE. & SW., dense willow undergrowth.

67.80 Five Mile Creek, 30 lks. wide, course SW.

68.25 Leave undergrowth; enter G. W. Sloneker's garden, course NE. & NW.

78.00 Leave garden, course E. & W.; steep ascent.

79.00 Sloneker's road, course E. & W.

80.73 The cor. of secs. 13 and 24, heretofore described.

July 29th, 1905.

N.0°34'E., on blank line, on E. bdy. of Sec. 13.

Ascend in Sloneker's orchard.

2.00 Leave orchard, course W. Down timber.

6.00 Top of spur on line, course SE.

Enter green timber; descend NE. slope.

11.00 Dry ravine, course SE.

18.00 Top of spur, course SE.; steep descent about 200 ft.

23.50 Deep canyon, course E. Steep spurs and canyons, course E.

40.15 1/4 sec. cor., which is a chitterwood, 12 ins. in diam., marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, is 40 lks. W.
