CHAINS

A hemlock stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S.10°E., 24 lks. dist.

A hemlock stump, 30 ins. diam., bears S.74°W., 53 lks. dist.

All were considerably decayed, but showed some signs of the original marks, though none decipherable.

I find no remains of the old post so set a new post at proper distance and bearing from said hemlock bearing tree stumps, 4½ ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to Townships 19 & 20 S. of Ranges 11 & 12 West, marked T 19 S S 31 on NE., R 11 W S 6 on SE., T 20 S S 1 on SW. and R 12 W S 36 on NW. faces, with 6 notches on each edge; from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.49½°E., 11 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 11 W S 31 B T.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S.41½°E., 41 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 6 B T.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S.8¼°W., 22 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 12 W S 1 B T.

An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N.47°W., 37 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 12 W S 36 B T.

Thence I run East on South boundary of Sec. 31.

Descend. Var. 20½°E.

2.50 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course North.

Thence along up a North slope.

17.50 Top of little spur, course North.

28.75 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW.

38.00 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ S on N. face; from which

An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S.77½°E., 21 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N.40°W., 16 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.
