- 40.00 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face; from which
An alder, 5 ins. diam., bears S. $25\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 44 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 73 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 47.34 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW.
- 56.50 Top of spur, course N. 60° W. +100
- 70.25 Hollow, course North.
- 72.85 Stream, 3 lks. wide, course NW.
- 80.00 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 32, 33, 4 & 5, marked T 19 S S 33 on NE., T 20 S S 4 on SE., R 11 W S 5 on SW. and S 32 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on West and 4 on E. edges; from which
A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $76\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 14 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 11 W S 32 B T.
An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 66° E., 175 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 11 W S 33 B T.
A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 140 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 4 B T.
An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $38\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 25 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 5 B T.

Descend.

- 9.50 Enter bottom of Fiddle Creek, in a little cove. -100
- 31.90 Fir, 5 ft. diam.
- 37.90 Fiddle Creek, course N. 60° W. from East. Offset South 1.45 chs. to avoid creek.
