A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.24°E., 21 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 32 B T. A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.65°W., 50 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 31 B T. A vine maple, 4 ins. diam., bears N.2°W., 14 lks. dist., marked T 20 S R 11 W S 30 B T.
