

## Subdivisions of T. 20 S., R. 11 W.

CHAINS

A willow, 5 ins. dia., bears S.76°E., 73 lks. dist.,  
marked T 20 S R 11 W S. 5 B T.

A willow, 5 ins. dia., bears S.25°W., 71 lks. dist.,  
marked T 20 S R 11 W S 6 B T.

A willow, 5 ins. dia., bears N.80°W., 42 lks. dist.,  
marked T 19 S R 11 W S 31 B T.

Thence I run

S.0°54'W., on true line, bet. secs. 5 & 6.

Var.20°14'E.

Through level marsh.

11.94 Left bank of Fiddle Creek, course S.20°E.

Set a post, 5 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground,  
for meander cor. to frac. secs. 5 and 6, marked M C on  
S., T 20 S on N., R 11 W S 5 on E., S 6 on W. face; from  
which

An alder, 4 ins. dia., bears N.60°W., 6 lks. dist.,  
marked T 20 S R 11 W S 6 M C B T.

No tree in Section 5 within limits, impossible to  
throw up mound or dig pits, as the water covers the  
ground.

12.64 Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground,  
on right bank of Fiddle Creek, for meander cor. to frac.  
secs. 5 & 6, marked M C on N., T 20 S on S., R 11 W S 5  
on E., S 6 on W. faces. No trees within limits on  
account of water; it is impossible to dig pits or throw  
up mounds. As the water is too deep in places to wade  
and chain through it, I set a flag S.0°54'W. on line,  
then lay off a base S.66 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 1.00 chain; flag bears  
S.15°W., making southing of 405 lks.

16.69	Top of rise; begin descent.	+40
19.40	Gibson's house bears E. 70 lks.; begin ascent.	-20
27.00	Top of spur, bears E. & W.; descend.	+75
30.06	Foot of descent; enter marsh, bears E. & W. As the same is about 2 ft. under water, I set a flag on edge of Fiddle Creek on line; thence run base N.75°W., 3.00
